Description and Event Agenda

The Latin American Summit for Innovation and Social Entrepreneurship consists of a 3 day encounter in which academics, students and professors of the Latin American Universities and guests from European Universities that are part of the Students4Change project. The main objective of Students4Change is to improve the quality and importance of academic programs that are aimed at the development of innovation and social entrepreneurship in Latin American Universities. The goal is to increase the ability to solve urgent social issues that our region faces.

Objectives of the Summit:

- Learn about the most important projects that include the know-how and tools developed within the framework of Students4Change with the goal of promoting a culture of entrepreneurship and social innovation at the universities from an expertise scope.
- Identify strategies to support and sustain an entrepreneurship and social innovation ecosystem within the Latin American academic institutions that are part of the project.
- Contribute to the strengthening and consolidation of a working network between universities, academics and students through the sharing of personal experiences and challenges faced in an international environment.

Down below, a brief description of the main activities of the event will be provided:

Activities for the general public:

- Grand opening of the summit: The beginning activity of the summit in which the event will be formally kicked-off. It will feature the presence of leaders of the host institution UNIMINUTO as well as the participation of one of the students that was involved in the project. Additionally, there will be a brief presentation of the Students4Change project, the achievements and its future goals.
- **Panel of experts:** We will have the participation of the following experts who will share the attendees their experiences and knowledge surrounding entrepreneurship and social





innovation. Such is quintessential to create an environment of critical thinking to develop sustainable strategies of their programs on university campuses.

- **Social Innovation ecosystem at UNIMINUTO:** Faculty and students will provide a tour of the different service areas related to the development of social innovation projects on campus. The purpose is to show the way in which academics connect with the social environment.
- Academic Dialogues: Faculties of the participating universities will present their evaluations
 of being part of the project as part of its pilot program. Subsequently, students and faculty
 will break down the development of innovation and social entrepreneurship inside the
 classroom.
- Presentations of the Pilot Courses: It is a session in which the student delegates of each
 university will present their projects. The aim is for them to share the achievements and
 learning outcomes of the implementation of the pilot program during the second semester
 of 2018. Additionally, this activity has the objective that networking between universities
 enrich academic cooperation.
- Capitalization of achievements of each Institution: In this session directors, students and professors participate in the working meeting. The purpose is to reach a consensus over the scaling and sustainability of social innovation in the academic programs of their respective universities.

Activities for the Directors:

- Presentation of Parque Científico de Innovación Social (PCIS) and its platforms. The directors
 of the Latin American Universities will be able to experience the operation and
- The directors from the Latin American Universities will have the opportunity to deeply know the PCIS, and how it supports the academic functions of the university, as teaching, research, and social impact. The PCIS is an important figure to help to understand the surrounding areas, their needs, actors and allies required for social innovative initiatives.
- Where are we now and where are we headed?: Workshops for directors of the different Institutions focused on stressing the details of the project as well as the issues and commitments made for the future of innovation and social entrepreneurship within each university.





• How to take advantage of the results from the Student4Change project?: Workshops for directors focused on establishing how to make good use and capitalize the results obtained from the Students4Change project.

Activities for the Students4Change Technical Staff:

- **General Assembly Meetings:** meetings of the project's technical staff of each Institution to examine specifics when managing and developing the project.
- Quality Committee meeting: meetings of the universities that comprise the Quality Committee to examine specifics when managing and developing the project.
- **Sesiones de Grupos Focales (***Focus Group***)**: Workshops organized by an external organization, Columbus, to evaluate results and the scope of the project. Such workshops will be conducted with students, faculty and the partners of the consortium.
